DEFEND DISSENT. HR 9495 <https://www.congress.gov/bill/118th-congress/house-bill/9495>, see Section 4] is a bill that would make it easier to shut down nonprofits, especially those opposing US weapons to Israel. Under this bill, nonprofits that “support terrorism” can lose their nonprofit status. However, the State Department can pretty much declare any organization terrorist, including those which provide strictly humanitarian assistance. There already was one defeat of the bill when it was attempted to slip it through “under suspension” but that required a 2/3 majority. 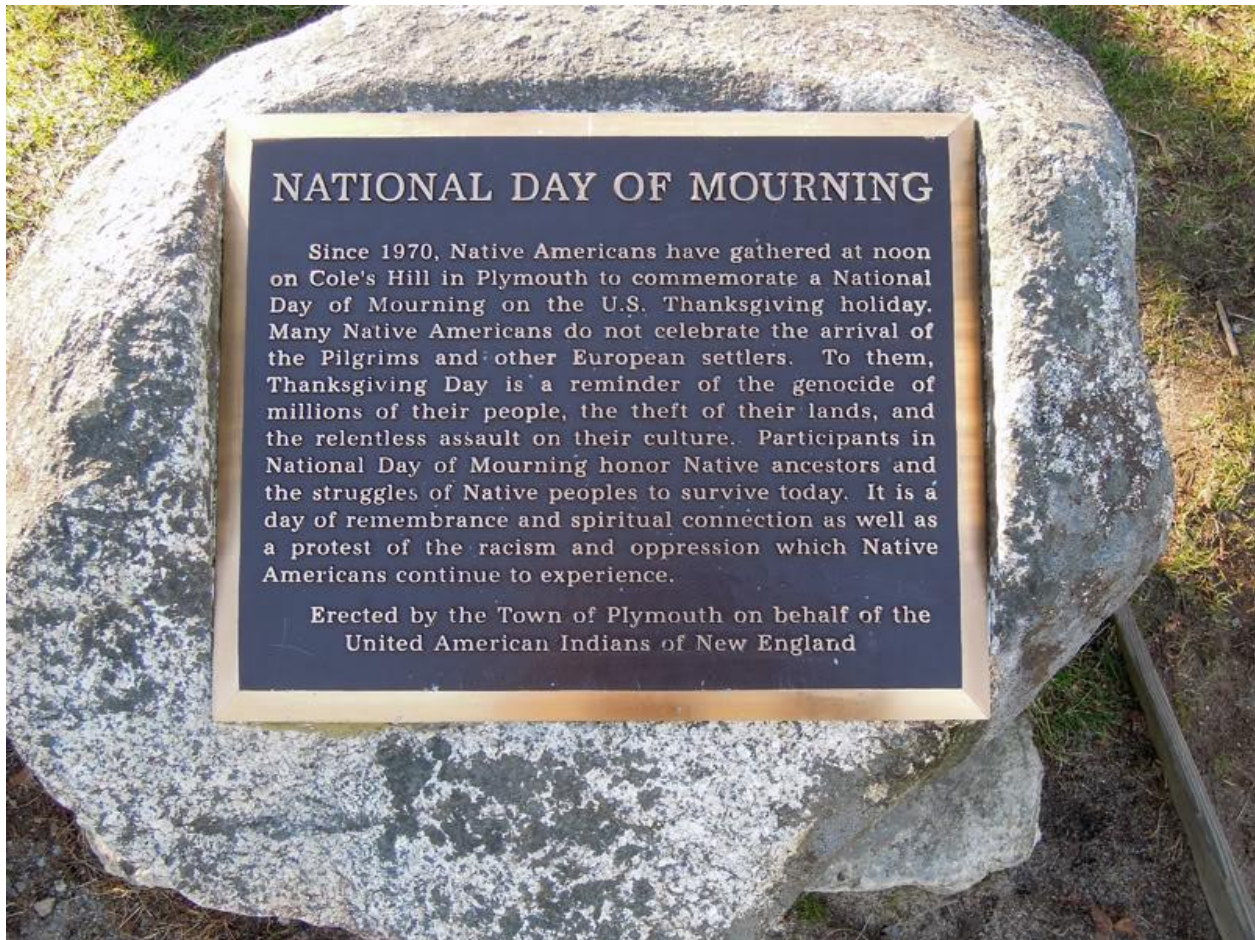

Venezuelans went to the polls on July 28 for a Presidential election with an imperialist pistol pressed firmly against their skulls. ## EYEWITNESS PALESTINE VIRTUAL TOUR FROM REFUGEE CAMP

Weds Nov 27, 9-10 am Pacific time, online

Join Eyewitness Palestine for this virtual tour. Located east of Ramallah, Al Am'ari Camp is one of the smallest refugee camps in the West Bank, with a registered population of 15,315, including 5,048 children. Despite its small size, the camp encapsulates the severe challenges faced by Palestinian refugees living under Israeli military occupation. The residents of Al Am'ari frequently endure invasions by the Israeli Occupation Forces, further exacerbating their already precarious living conditions. These incursions disrupt daily life and instill fear and uncertainty, particularly among children, who bear the brunt of the trauma. Adding to the hardships, the illegal expansion of nearby Israeli settlements has severely restricted the movement of camp residents.

Al Am'ari is one of 23 refugee camps in the West Bank and one of 59 refugee camps administered by the United Nations Relief and Works Agency (UNRWA) across the West Bank, Gaza, Syria, Jordan, and Lebanon.

## NATIONAL DAY OF MOURNING

Thurs Nov 28

From Wikipedia “The National Day of Mourning is an annual demonstration, held on the fourth Thursday in November, that aims to educate the public about Native Americans in the United States, notably the Wampanoag and other tribes of the Eastern United States; dispel myths surrounding the Thanksgiving story in the United States; and raise awareness toward historical and ongoing struggles facing Native American tribes. The first National Day of Mourning demonstration was held in 1970 after Frank "Wamsutta" James's speaking invitation was rescinded from a Massachusetts Thanksgiving Day celebration commemorating the 350th anniversary of the landing of the Mayflower. James instead delivered his speech on Cole's Hill in Plymouth, Massachusetts next to a statue of Ousamequin, where he described Native American perspectives on the Thanksgiving celebrations. The gathering became an annual event organized by the United American Indians of New England (UAINE) and coincides with both Thanksgiving Day in the United States and with Unthanksgiving Day, an annual ceremony held on Alcatraz Island in California.”

## US MID-RANGE WEAPONS IN GERMANY WEBINAR

Thurs Dec 5, 10 am Pacific time, Zoom

The Abolition 2000 Global Network to Eliminate Nuclear Weapons is hosting a webinar. On the sidelines of the NATO summit in Washington D.C., on July 20, 2024, US President Biden and German Chancellor Scholz announced a major bilateral agreement: "The United States will begin episodic deployments of the long-range fires capabilities of its Multi-Domain Task Force in Germany in 2026, as part of planning for enduring stationing of these capabilities in the future."

What is behind the introduction of US long-range conventional missiles in Germany? What role do such conventional strike weapons play in US war planning? What are the escalation risks of the planned deployment? And why are many Germans more than worried?

Dan Plesch, Professor of Diplomacy and Strategy at SOAS University of London, is the co-author with Manuel Galileo of the recent report “Masters of the Air: Strategic stability and conventional strike”. Regina Hagen, spokesperson of the German network “atomwaffenfrei.jetzt” (nuclear-weapons-free now) and a member of the Coordinating Committee of Abolition 2000, is co-founder of the new campaign “Friedensfähig statt erstschlagfähig” that, calls for an immediate halt of the planned deployment. Andrew Lichterman, a lawyer and policy analyst at the Western States Legal Foundation and a member of the Coordinating Committees of Abolition 2000 and the U.S.-based network United for Peace and Justice, will moderate the discussion.
