### **STOP** WAR ON IRAN

- Send letters to Congress to say **Stop Trump's war** with Iran at <https://actionnetwork.org/letters/stop-trumps-war-with-iran/>. You can use this opportunity to thank the WA Senators and if your WA Rep is a Democrat, you can thank them also for supporting last week's War Powers Resolutions that would have told Trump to stop this war. See below for the link to the roll call in the House.
- We were saddened that the House failed to pass "H.Con.Res.38 - Directing the President pursuant to section 5(c) of the **War Powers Resolution** to remove United States Armed Forces from **unauthorized hostilities in the Islamic Republic of Iran**" on March

4, 2026. The main sponsor of this resolution was Thomsas Massie, a Republican, one of 2 from his party to cast a yea vote. The roll call vote (see <https://www.congress.gov/votes/house/119-2/85>) was 219 nays, 212 yeas, with 4 democrats among the nays. Had the 4 Democrats voted yea, it would have passed.

- The Senate rejected a similar measure, “S.J.Res.104 - A joint resolution to direct the removal of United States Armed Forces from **hostilities within or against the Islamic Republic of Iran** that have not been authorized by Congress.” One Senator from each major party broke party lines.
- **Murders or war crimes?** Either way, it’s illegal and immoral. 200 **schoolgirls** and women killed, with analysis now indicating this was a U.S. strike, and not only one strike but “double tap” designed to kill survivors and first responders. Without warning in the middle of the school day. Nearly 200 **sailors in an unarmed Iranian ship** in international waters killed, including survivors who were left to drown by the U.S.

- GAZA. READING FROM CESAR CHAVEZ, AUTOBIOGRAPHY OF LA CAUSA

The Whatcom Democratic Socialists of America Political Education Committee invites you to join them in their March reading, from Cesar Chavez, Autobiography of La Causa. We will be reading Book II, Uprooted and Adrift, 1939 to 1952, pages 43 to 93.

This section, from one of the most important books on American labor history, details the dispossession, poverty and racism experienced by labor leader Cesar Chavez as a child, which then and now enables the labor exploitation our American food system has historically been based on. The generational survival of racism depends on the denial of historical racism, and many are not aware of the open and enforced racial segregation inflicted upon farm workers of color in the Western United States historically. The first time Cesar Chavez was arrested was for sitting in the Whites Only section of a movie theater when he was a member of the Navy.

This historical racism foundationally enables ICE atrocities inflicted upon people of color today. Within the context of these current atrocities, join Whatcom DSA in challenging the racist silencing and denial of the history of American racism, that we may better support people of color, workers, farm workers and other food system workers against the racism of 2026.
