STOP WAR ON IRAN

- **BLOCKADE? HEY DONALD TRUMP.** Maybe you didn't notice that a blockade (such as the one the U.S. is inflicting on Iran) is **an act of war and a war crime.** See <https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Blockade>. Trump says the 60 day limit on hostilities before getting approval from Congress doesn't count because the "ceasefire" puts a pause on the clock. However, as long as there is a blockade, an act of war, there is no ceasefire.

- **ISRAEL-GAZA-THE WORLD.** See <https://globalsumudflotilla.org/> for the latest news. Another **international flotilla was underway** to sail to Gaza protesting Israel's blockade, when they were intercepted by the Israeli military in international waters 500 miles from Gaza or Israel. The international activists were violently apprehended, and as of May 1, two are still in Israeli custody. You can **subscribe for email updates** at the website above.

VOTING RIGHTS.

- In their latest decision, these billionaire-backed [Supreme Court] justices **gutted a key part of the Voting Rights Act**, making it easier for state legislatures to draw up district maps that **dilute the voting power of Black and brown communities.** This is how they help politicians control election outcomes before votes are even cast. DEATH PENALTY

- *The Trump Administration has proposed regulation changes which allow the US Attorney General to **interfere in state procedure and shorten appeals processes**. These changes would result in speedier and more executions. Read more and sign a petition at <https://actionnetwork.org/petitions/638f274538e863d23958e5c96dfa364d0c359f75/>. If you sign you will receive an email telling you how to submit a comment to the government (through May 15) to help prevent these destructive changes.*

Rep Jayapal says “Earlier this month, I traveled to Cuba with Representative Jonathan Jackson of Illinois. The illegal U.S. blockade of fuel to Cuba is causing enormous suffering to the Cuban people. This is cruel collective punishment—effectively an economic bombing of the infrastructure of the country—that has produced permanent damage.

“I would like to invite you to join me ... for an in-person briefing in Seattle about what I saw during my time in Cuba and a panel discussion on the urgent need for true reform. There will be an opportunity for you to ask questions and hear firsthand from local experts on Cuba.”

AI: MAKING EMPLOYEE DISEMPOWERMENT NEW AGAIN

Thurs May 7, 10 am Pacific time, Zoom

There is much panic around AI's impact on the labor market. Efforts to blame inequality and unemployment on AI and technology divert attention from the root cause: excess employer power. The best "AI policy" to protect workers would be boosting workers' power by improving social insurance systems, removing barriers to organizing unions, and sustaining lower rates of unemployment.
