#### OTHER WARS U.S. is promoting

- **LEBANON.** *Israel's war on Lebanon has killed over 3000 people including children and adult civilians. Yet the U.S. is illegally and immorally providing military aid to Israel. Tell Congress: Vote YES on the Lebanon War Powers Resolution!*

OPPOSING ICE AND BORDER PATROL VIOLENCE AND DENIAL OF RIGHTS: support our immigrant neighbors, whether free or imprisoned, and the people peacefully defending them.

- **Tell Congress: Vote NO on the \$70B Blank Check for ICE.** ICE kidnaps and imprisons innocent people living quiet lawful lives. Their prisons, many run by for profit corporations, are notorious for violence, inedible food, solitary confinement, and other abuses. Congress may vote on this money when they get back from break this week. Write letters from <https://actionnetwork.org/letters/tell-congress-vote-no-on-the-70b-blank-check-for-ice/>.

- **Legal Assistance for Alligator Alcatraz inmates.** 1500 immigrants have been imprisoned under inhumane conditions. Many of them could be eligible for release, but they need legal representation to get that. Alligator Alcatraz is closing. That would be reason for joy if the prisoners were being released, but most of them will be transferred to other horrible prisons. The Workers Circle is raising money for lawyers to get as many of them as possible released. #### CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHTS & DOMESTIC AFFAIRS

- **THE DRAFT.** The Trump administration wants to make registernig for the draft automatic. Fellowship of Reconciliation USA, Veterans for Peace, AFSC, and many other organizations have signed onto a “Statement **Opposing the “Automatic” Registration of Individuals for a Possible Military Draft**” See [https://comdsd.org/pdf/Joint\\_Statement\\_Opposing\\_Automatic\\_S

- **THE DRAFT.** Special rules for **medical workers**. All “fit” men aged 18 to 25 are susceptible to the draft, but for certain health care workers, there’s the “Health Care Personnel Delivery System” which applies to men aged up to 44. The Mike Yarrow Peace Fellowship (MYPF) is a long-term training program of Western Washington Fellowship of Reconciliation (WWFOR) that includes a Fellowship grant of \$500 to work on a nonviolent social change project of your choice. The MYPF program recruits and trains high school and college age youth in the theory and practice of active nonviolence on issues of peace, climate, and social justice in the traditions of Martin Luther King and Mahatma Gandhi. Intensive online training in Nonviolent Action will take place around the 2026 Labor Day weekend. Participants will then plan and carry out a project in their school or community from September 2026 until April 15, 2027. Mentors and additional resources will be available throughout the program year.

Across Africa and the Global South, movements for justice, sovereignty, and peace are gaining momentum through international advocacy for reparations, shifting geopolitical dynamics in the Sahel, renewed alliances among formerly colonized nations, and grassroots organizing led by activists and diasporas. Grounded in the principles of the UN Charter, these efforts challenge ongoing forms of domination and call for a more just global order.

This event invites participants to reflect and act: is the “war against Africa” continuing in new forms, what responsibilities do European citizens bear, and how can we build meaningful African-European alliances for peace?
