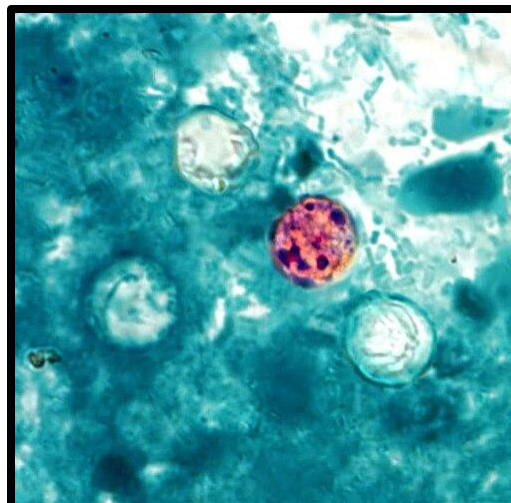

STOP & PREVENT U.S. WARS EVERYWHERE

- U.S. WAR ON IRAN. Go to <https://www.whitehouse.gov/contact/> to send a message to the President. You can leave a message as short as “END THE WAR ON IRAN”. Postal mail can go to

- *EFFECTS OF U.S. WAR ON IRAN*, National Iranian American Council is a source of information. Trump's war on Iran has not increased **human rights** in Iran, quite the contrary. The war is having **drastic effects on the civilian population**. - *U.S.-ISRAEL*. A step toward ending U.S. complicity in Israeli warfare and genocide – on Wed July 15, 104 Representatives voted to **remove \$3.3 billion U.S. aid to Israel** from the National Defense Authorization Act. See the roll call at <https://clerk.house.gov/Votes/2026243>. WA Reps Smith, Randall and Jayapal voted "aye" to remove the funding. You could thank them. As to the rest, -maybe they need some more information.
- *GAZA "CEASEFIRE" DOESN'T EXIST*. U.S continues to help Israel commit genocide. See a video Gazan journalist Mosab Abu Toha at <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=rGoUfPiD2jw>.

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OPPOSING ICE AND BORDER PATROL VIOLENCE AND DENIAL OF RIGHTS: **First they came for the immigrants.**

- *BE AN OBSERVER.* Washington Immigrant Solidarity Network is tracking ICE activity. You can help. If you witness any immigration activity or arrests first-hand, or if your family has been impacted by an enforcement operation, please call the WAISN Deportation Defense Hotline at 1-844-724-3737 [HOURS 6 am – 6 pm] . If your call does not go to staff, please send a text message TO 1-844-724-3737. If you have pictures or video of activity, please text them to the Hotline or email them to us at hotline@waisn.org with a location, date, and time. Also see many WAISN events listed in this email.
- *MORE KILLING BY ICE.* A week ago, we noted the killing of Lorenzo Salgado Araujo by ICE agents claiming self-defense. Less than a week later, Joan Sebastián Durán Guerrero was killed by agents claiming to protect public safety. Meanwhile, immigrant prisoners held in dismal conditions and with many instances of medical neglect are dying. As are recently released prisoners who “don’t count” even if they are released without resources to remain alive. 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CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHTS & DOMESTIC AFFAIRS

- **THE RIGHT TO KNOW WHAT YOU'RE EATING?** Complete and honest labeling of food is still controversial – the question of whether GMO foods need to be labeled as such is a recent example. Yet most of us expect the government to protect us from food that is harmful – mercury in fish, lead in turmeric, *E. coli* in hamburgers, and ***Cyclospora cayetanensis*** in salad greens. See Wikipedia article <https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Cyclosporiasis> which states “In the United States, *Cyclospora* prevalence was tracked through the Foodborne Diseases Active Surveillance Network (FoodNet) system until 2025, when budget cuts resulted in the CDC no longer mandating reporting of the disease.” Cuts in funding for the agencies which try to protect us (CDC, FDA, Dept. of Agriculture, etc.) have results, possibly lethal ones.
- **THE RIGHT TO DECENT WORK CONDITIONS.** For decades farmworkers and their unions have fought for the right to proper sanitation on the job. This means toilets and the ability to wash their hands! The ***Cyclospora cayetanensis*** outbreak may well be the result of farmworkers having to relieve themselves in open fields. - **PROTECT THE RIGHT TO VOTE.** Sign a petition that says “It is illegal for a president to deploy armed military or federal agents to polling sites, but that hasn’t stopped President Trump from threatening to use armed agents at voting locations. Congress must act urgently to protect our elections from potential

interference by passing the Protect Our Polls Act.” at <https://act.winwithoutwar.org/act/no-troops-polls> See the current cosponsors of this bill at <https://www.congress.gov/bill/119th-congress/senate-bill/4845/cosponsors>

- *THE RIGHT TO BE WHO YOU ARE. End discrimination against LGBTQ people, and especially end forced “conversion therapy. Read more and sign the petition “Conversion Therapy for Children Is Abuse. US States Must Continue to Fight This Discredited Practice” at <https://www.thepetitionsite.com/248/443/344/>*
- *THE RIGHT TO LIFE, OPPOSING THE DEATH PENALTY. We have always opposed the death penalty and were among the organizations which worked to abolish it in Washington State. Now Florida is having an execution “spree.” Floridians for Alternatives to the Death Penalty is working to spare the lives of two prisoners scheduled to die July 28. 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NSPM-7: A THREAT TO PRESS FREEDOM

Weds July 22, 11 am Pacific time, Zoom

The national security presidential memorandum known as NSPM-7, titled "Countering Domestic Terrorism and Organized Political Violence," has been widely criticized by civil liberties groups for authorizing the government to investigate individuals and organizations using the vague and overbroad labels like "anti-fascism" and "domestic terrorism." But relatively little attention has been paid to the way the policy could be used against news outlets, journalists, and their

confidential sources. The Freedom of the Press Foundation (FPF) will host this event:

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PADDLE TO NISQUALLY,

July 31-Aug 6

The 2026 Paddle to Nisqually Medicine Creek Potlatch is hosted by the Nisqually Tribe.

Canoe Journey 2026, Paddle to Nisqually Medicine Creek Potlatch, continues an inter-tribal celebration and annual gathering of Northwest indigenous nations. The annual tribal journey in the Pacific Northwest region was sparked by the Paddle to Seattle in 1989 as part of Washington State's Centennial celebration. Many Canoe Journeys have

been held since 1989, when pullers (the preferred term because of the pulling motion on the paddle) from Canada, Alaska and Washington voyaged from their home communities to sites in the Pacific Northwest. The Canoe Journey has grown to include over 100 canoes and the participation of Canoe Families from other native canoe cultures, including Native American tribes, First Nations peoples, Alaska Natives, Inuit, Maori, Native Hawaiians, and other indigenous peoples from across the world.

Canoe Journey gatherings are rich in meaning and cultural significance. Canoe families travel great distances as their ancestors did and participating in the journey requires physical and spiritual discipline. At each stop, canoe families follow certain protocols, they ask for permission to come ashore, often in their native languages. At night in longhouses there is gifting, honoring and the sharing of traditional prayers, drumming, songs and dances. Meals, including evening dinners of traditional foods, are provided by the host nations.

The Nisqually Tribe has participated in the annual Canoe Journeys since 1994 and has used the Canoe Journeys to strengthen its culture, its community, and its families. Historical cultural practices, from carving techniques to gifting ceremonies, cedar weaving to regalia making, have been revived and rediscovered, while songs have resurfaced to be shared at Journey's end. The Tribe's pride of place and history are once again enriching the lives of young and old alike. The Nisqually Canoe family has learned and taught many of the older skills, and these practices are once again taken up by tribal community members.
