EXCLUSIVE INTERVIEW WITH JIMOTHY

WWFOR email editor (Wee): Jimothy thank you for agreeing to speak with us!

Jimothy: A pleasure to talk to nonviolent humans!

Wee: What would you like our readers to know about your situation?

Jimothy: Well, everybody already knows I’m not the average raccoon. But growing up I had no idea about that. We raccoons don’t usually have mirrors. But my mother and my siblings loved me.

Wee: When did you feel there was something special about you?

Jimothy: Well sometimes I was a little slower than my sibs, and occasionally I got stuck in odd places. But that was ok – my family helped me along, and they were patient.

Wee: So, what's the most important thing you'd like to say to our readers?

Jimothy: It's okay to be different. Everybody should tell that to their kids. Not everyone has a family as supportive as mine. If your family doesn't support you, you can find friends who do! Be yourself, however you are!

Wee: Any final thoughts?

Jimothy: Oh yes, I have plenty more to say to the humans! Stop cutting down trees! We need them – humans and raccoons both. Also stop using all those herbicides – a few dandelions won't hurt your yard, and they are delicious. And stop using poisons. Some of us eat bugs and worms. We only have one earth, and we have to take care of it and learn how to share it.

Wee: Thank you for sharing your thoughts, Jimothy!

- **WAR BUDGET OVER A TRILLION.** *If you believe that tax money should be spent on human needs (medical care, housing, food, etc.) and that the trillion plus dollars for defense spending in the NDAA is way too much, then “Tell Congress: Pass the Slash the Pentagon Act to cut Trump's war budget in half and invest in people instead” at <https://act.winwithoutwar.org/act/slash-the-pentagon>*
- **U.S. WAR ON IRAN.** *End this war! Thanks to Rep Pramila Jayapal for spearheading H.Con.Res.89, a War Powers Resolution, to remove the U.S. from hostilities with Iran. On Thursday July 23, the Resolution passed in the house 214 to 210, and was sent to the Senate for consideration. See details at <https://www.congress.gov/bill/119th-congress/house-concurrent-resolution/89>. Also, it's urgent to get Congress to defund this war. “To Every Member of the United States Senate. Do not authorize more money for Donald Trump’s illegal, immoral, and idiotic war against the people of Iran. Not the \$70 billion that was jammed through in the House of Representatives.” Sign a petition at <https://act.citizen.org/page/100765/petition/1>.*
- **U.S.-ISRAEL.** *The House passed the NDAA (funding for 2027) H. R. 8800 with a provision (Section 219) that increases cooperation between the U.S, and Israel. See the roll call at <https://clerk.house.gov/Votes/2026278>. You can use this information to thank your Rep for a nay vote or express your disappointment for a yea vote. Then use the site <https://act.uscpr.org/a/ndaa> to make phone calls to Senators to say “Stop the deadly U.S.-Israeli military integration” with a suggested script.*
- **CUBA-U.S.** *Who knew what a threat tiny Cuba is to the U.S.? Brace yourself and read the State Department document at <https://www.state.gov/wp-content/uploads/2026/07/Cuba->*

[Report.pdf](#). Cuba has “has waged a sustained campaign of subversion against the United States ... [and] ... has infiltrated the highest reaches of the U.S. government.” If that doesn’t have you shaking in your boots, you can read about nefarious Pastors for Peace sending humanitarian aid to Cuba. Read about “The National Lawyers Guild (NLG) is one of the most ... insidious organizations in Cuba’s U.S. network.”

All this appears to be building a basis for a U.S. attack on Cuba – as if the U.S. wasn’t already starving the nation with its blockade, as if the U.S. hadn’t conducted a campaign against Cuba including multiple assassination attempts against Castro and at least one CIA-funded invasion [see https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Bay_of_Pigs_Invasion]. - ISRAEL-WEST BANK. Israeli settlers in occupied West Bank have been increasingly violent and destructive, attacking homes, mosques, and farms. The Israeli soldiers, in theory preventing this violence, often stand by. An email subject line from the Israeli newspaper Haaretz reads, “IDF reservist says West Bank forces can't deal with settler violence so they ‘stand by and watch’.” Sometimes it is the IDF doing the attacking and destruction, see <https://www.middleeastmonitor.com/20260725-the-spark-in-tell-how-a-village-resistance-disrupted-israels-west-bank-strategy/>. Over a thousand Palestinians, including over 200 children, have been killed in West Bank since the current Gaza war began.
- ISRAEL GAZA. The killing of Gazan civilians including children continues. See <https://www.dropsitenews.com/p/gaza-israel-escalated-attacks-yellow-line-displacement> “Israel Firebombed a Family Home Where Children Were Sleeping in Latest Killing Spree” The imprisonment and torture of Gazans in Israel

CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHTS & DOMESTIC AFFAIRS

- *THE RIGHT TO DISSENT.* “Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof; or abridging the freedom of speech, or of the press; or the right of the people peaceably to assemble, and to petition the Government for a redress of grievances.” Read more and Demand Congress investigate Trump’s Justice Department for criminalizing dissent at <https://actionnetwork.org/letters/investigate-doj-for-criminalizing-dissent/>
- *CULTURAL PRESERVATION, WILDERNESS PRESERVATION.* Bears Ears National Monument is one of the sites Trump wants to shrink and turn over to mining companies, despite its cultural significance to several tribal nations. In addition, Trump has removed the seals of native tribes which has agreed to co-management from the Monument signs. Sign a petition to Congress to take action and restore the larger Monument at <https://secure.countonme.org/the-democratic-conservation-alliance/utmonuments>. - *PROTECT THE RIGHT TO VOTE.* The SAVE Act which makes it more difficult to register to vote is still rattling around. WAR CRIMES IN PALESTINE: PRESENTATION & DISCUSSION

Tues July 28, 7 pm, at Orca Books Cooperative, 315 5th Ave SE, Olympia

Join Economics for Everyone (E4E) and the Rachel Corrie Foundation (RCF) War Crimes in Palestine: a discussion with journalist Gabb Schivone at Orca Books. In addition to the US Government, many US citizens are joining the Israeli army and are themselves committing war crimes in Gaza and the West Bank. Some of these soldiers have documented and publicly shared their destruction of Palestinian homes through social media. These soldiers have subsequently become the subjects of cases issued by the International Criminal Court.

Gabb Schivone, who has published for Drop Site News, Rolling Stone and others, will share their investigative reporting on the calls to bring accused war criminals to justice. Gabb will also discuss their experiences on the Gaza Freedom Flotilla II in 2011, which launched from Greece during the social uprisings against government austerity. PADDLE TO NISQUALLY,

July 31-Aug 6

The 2026 Paddle to Nisqually Medicine Creek Potlatch is hosted by the Nisqually Tribe.

Canoe Journey 2026, Paddle to Nisqually Medicine Creek Potlatch, continues an inter-tribal celebration and annual gathering of Northwest indigenous nations. The annual tribal journey in the Pacific Northwest region was sparked by the Paddle to Seattle in 1989 as part of Washington State's Centennial celebration. Many Canoe Journeys have been held since 1989, when pullers (the preferred term because of the pulling motion on the paddle) from Canada, Alaska and Washington voyaged from their home communities to sites in the Pacific Northwest. The Canoe Journey has grown to include over 100 canoes and the participation of Canoe Families from other native canoe cultures, including Native American tribes, First Nations peoples, Alaska Natives, Inuit, Maori, Native Hawaiians, and other indigenous peoples from across the world.

Canoe Journey gatherings are rich in meaning and cultural significance. Canoe families travel great distances as their ancestors did and participating in the journey requires physical and spiritual discipline. At each stop, canoe families follow certain protocols, they ask for permission to come ashore, often in their native languages. At night in longhouses there is gifting, honoring and the sharing of traditional prayers, drumming, songs and dances. Meals, including evening dinners of traditional foods, are provided by the host nations.

The Nisqually Tribe has participated in the annual Canoe Journeys since 1994 and has used the Canoe Journeys to strengthen its culture, its community, and its families. Historical cultural practices, from carving techniques to gifting ceremonies, cedar weaving to regalia making, have been revived and rediscovered, while songs have resurfaced to be

shared at Journey's end. The Tribe's pride of place and history are once again enriching the lives of young and old alike. The Nisqually Canoe family has learned and taught many of the older skills, and these practices are once again taken up by tribal community members.
