- NOT JUST IN ISRAEL-PALESTINE. The U.S. is unjustly imprisoning many peaceful productive members of our communities including immigrants and peaceful protesters.

- **STILL FIGHTING AGAINST ABRIDGEMENT OF VOTING RIGHTS.** The SAVE ACT will make it more difficult or impossible for many qualified voters to vote. It passed the House as part of the NDAA. Inuit, Maori, Native Hawaiians, and other indigenous peoples from across the world.

Canoe Journey gatherings are rich in meaning and cultural significance. Canoe families travel great distances as their ancestors did and participating in the journey requires physical and spiritual discipline. At each stop, canoe families follow certain protocols, they ask for permission to come ashore, often in their native languages. At night in longhouses there is gifting, honoring and the sharing of traditional prayers, drumming, songs and dances. Meals, including evening dinners of traditional foods, are provided by the host nations.

The Nisqually Tribe has participated in the annual Canoe Journeys since 1994 and has used the Canoe Journeys to strengthen its culture, its community, and its families. Historical cultural practices, from carving techniques to gifting ceremonies, cedar weaving to regalia making, have been revived and rediscovered, while songs have resurfaced to be shared at Journey's end. The Tribe's pride of place and history are once again enriching the lives of young and old alike. The Nisqually Canoe family has learned and taught many of the older skills, and these practices are once again taken up by tribal community members.

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PRIMARY ELECTION IN WASHINGTON STATE
REMEMBER TO VOTE!

Tues Aug 4, mostly by mail, registered voters should receive a ballot in the mail soon, it must be returned in official drop boxes by 8 pm or by postal mail postmarked by this date.

Not sure you're registered? You can check your status at <https://voter.votewa.gov/portal2023/login.aspx>

Register in time for the Primary Election by July 27 Online at <https://olvr.votewa.gov/OLVR2024/landing.aspx>, or by mail see <https://www.sos.wa.gov/elections/voters/voter-registration/print-voter-registration-form>. Or register in-person/same-day by August 4, 2026, at County Elections Offices, see <https://www.sos.wa.gov/elections/voters/voter-registration/county-elections-offices>.

Requirements to vote: Must be a U.S. citizen, at least 18 years old by Election Day, and a Washington State resident. Eligible 17-year-olds who will be 18 by the general election may also vote in the primary. Voting rights are automatically restored upon release from total confinement.

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FROM HIROSHIMA TO HOPE

Thurs Aug 6, 6 pm to dark, at Green Lake’s Northwest Shore, just south of the Bathhouse, near West Green Lake Drive North and Stone Ave North, Seattle

The event includes music, poetry, speakers and candle-lit lanterns floating on the lake. Marking the 81st anniversary of the atomic bombings of Hiroshima and Nagasaki, From Hiroshima to Hope honors the bombings' victims and all victims of war and violence.

Pre-program activities begin at 6 pm. and include lantern calligraphy, paper crane folding, and traditional Japanese music by Koto no WA.

The family program gets underway at 7 pm and features keynote speaker Christina Shimizu, Executive Director of the Wing Luke Museum, and emcee Dr. Shampa Biswas, Whitman College Professor of Politics and author of "Nuclear Desire: Power and the Postcolonial Nuclear Order." The program also includes the popular Japanese American drumming group, Seattle Kokon Taiko, along with music by performance youth group Totem Star. Poet Janae Lu, former 2024/25 Seattle Youth Poet Laureate and author of "In All Spaces Liminal," and Oonaugh Foster-Bill, co-winner of Hanford Challenge's Student Hot Poetry Contest, complete the program.

Based on the traditional toro nagashi ceremony, the evening concludes with lantern floating beginning at 8 pm with a procession to the lake, followed by the launch of nearly 1,000 lanterns inscribed with messages of peace and hope. The haunting notes of shakuhachi, played by Patrick Johnson, accompany the lantern floating.

The event also includes a historic photograph exhibit of the aftermath of the atomic bombings, and display of a fabric sculpture, "Little Boy (folded)" by artist Yukiyo Kawano. The sculpture is a full-scale replica of the Little Boy bomb dropped on Hiroshima.
