STOP & PREVENT U.S. WARS EVERYWHERE

- DON'T INCREASE U.S. COMPLICITY IN GENOCIDE AND OCCUPATION. The current NDAA has provisions for more U.S.-Israel military cooperation. Say NO! 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OPPOSING ICE AND BORDER PATROL VIOLENCE AND DENIAL OF RIGHTS: **First they came for the immigrants.**

- **BE AN OBSERVER.** Washington Immigrant Solidarity Network is tracking ICE activity. You can help. If you witness any immigration activity or arrests first-hand, or if your family has been impacted by an enforcement operation, please call the WAISN Deportation Defense Hotline at 1-844-724-3737 [HOURS 6 am – 6 pm] . If your call does not go to staff, please send a text message TO 1-844-724-3737. If you have pictures or video of activity, please text them to the Hotline or email them to us at hotline@waisn.org with a location, date, and time. Also see many WAISN events listed in this email.
- **CONDITIONS AT ICE PRISONS.** One more in a series of reports of Congress members trying to do due diligence inspections of conditions at immigrant prisons. Reps Jaypal of Washington State and Omar of Minnesota tried to learn about conditions of immigrant imprisoned at Whipple Federal Building but were largely prevented from doing so. This attempt is among many, and previous Congressional Reps have also been thwarted and even treated violently. 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CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHTS & DOMESTIC AFFAIRS

- **DON'T WEAKEN THE CONSUMER FINANCIAL PROTECTION BUREAU!** Read about proposed changes that would make CFPB less effective and take action at <https://actionnetwork.org/forms/put-the-cfpb-back-to-work-protecting-consumers/>.
- **STILL SAYING VOTE NO ON THE "SAVE AMERICA" ACT.** Despite the name, this is a voter suppression measure. 25 organizations have sponsored a letter writing site at <https://actionnetwork.org/letters/tell-the-senate-vote-no-on-the-save-america-act/>
- **TELL CONGRESS: FUND FEMA, NOT ICE.** Not only has the Trump administration slashed FEMA spending, but those remaining funds are allocated according to the political leanings of disaster localities. Meanwhile, ICE is tearing apart families, imprisoning peaceful productive people, and deporting people who did have permission to be in the U.S. In brief: FEMA helps people, ICE hurts people. - **DEATH PENALTY.** 25 people are on death row in Alabama because of "judicial override." These are cases in which the jury voted for life without parole, yet the judge unilaterally imposed a death sentence. This practice has since been made unlawful, yet these formerly sentenced prisoners remain on death row. The governor has the power to grant clemency. In 1492, Pope Nicholas granted the Portuguese the right to ‘conquer the lands of the infidels, expel their inhabitants, subjugate them and force them into eternal servitude’ along the coast of West Africa.

More than five centuries later, a critical question remains: Has the relationship between Western powers and Africa fundamentally changed or merely evolved in form? Patterns of external domination, exploitation, and destabilization continue to raise urgent concerns. Across Africa and the Global South, movements for justice, sovereignty, and peace are gaining momentum through international advocacy for reparations, shifting geopolitical dynamics in the Sahel, renewed alliances among formerly colonized nations, and grassroots organizing led by activists and diasporas. Grounded in the principles of the UN Charter, these efforts challenge ongoing forms of domination and call for a more just global order. This World Beyond War event invites participants to reflect and act: is the “war against Africa” continuing in new forms, what responsibilities do European citizens bear, and how can we build meaningful African-European alliances for peace? Join us to explore how citizen action can help end cycles of exploitation and advance dignity, equality, and lasting peace.
