Below are some suggestions: donate to feed hungry people; donate bond money to help an imprisoned immigrant get free; cheer an unjustly imprisoned protester with a friendly letter. And one more thing not mentioned below: if you meet the donor requirements **give blood**. It’s code-red urgent, you might save a life, it’s free, and you get a cookie! STOP & PREVENT U.S. WARS EVERYWHERE

- SAY NO TO POURING MONEY INTO ICBMS. Intercontinental ballistic missiles currently could be launched by the President alone; that's another problem to solve. Meanwhile, we can take the money away from modernizing the ICBMs. Ask your Rep Cosponsor H.R. 4685, the "Investing in Children Before Missiles Act of 2025." Currently no Washington Rep has signed on. - HELP GAZANS STILL IN GAZA AND IN EXILE. Many international organizations are providing help to Gazans, including the United Nations World Food Programme (donations <https://donate.wfpusa.org/page/UNWFP>), Doctors without Borders (donations <https://give.doctorswithoutborders.org/campaign/675296/donate>), and many more. Today we are **highlighting a local program**, the Seattle Gaza Mutual Aid, see <https://seattlegazamutualaid.org/>. *"We are supporting survivors of the war directly and through the establishment and running of the Meera Centre, an educational & healing center for children and families, the ongoing work of the Gaza Circus and through direct support to families in need. - TERRIBLE THINGS HAPPENING IN WEST BANK. Settlers murder Palestinians, demolish homes, uproot olive trees, kill sheep and

goats, destroy water pipes and electrical lines. The murder of a well-known Palestinian, Ahdah Hathaleen, was witnessed and recorded. OPPOSING ICE AND BORDER PATROL VIOLENCE AND DENIAL OF RIGHTS: **First they came for the immigrants.**

- **HELP BRING THE NEXT PERSON HOME FROM IMMIGRATION DETENTION**, Washington Immigrant Solidarity Network (WAISN) calls for our help to get community members out of prisons where they remain for lack of bail funds. You can contribute to the Fair Fight Bond Fund starting at https://secure.lglforms.com/form_engine/s/GpzDI92nRpdSTuYSisobQ.
- **HELP DACA (IMMIGRANT CHILDHOOD ARRIVALS) ENROLLEES REMAIN**. The Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) program started in 2012, to grant some kind of stability for those people brought to the U.S. as children. DACA recipients are under greater scrutiny than people born in the U.S. – any tiny skirmish with the law could get them deported. In addition, they have to reapply for DACA status every 2 years and pay a fee of \$555 each time. **That's a lot of money** – many DACA enrollees are in school, or just starting their careers, or starting families. - **EMERGENCY ROOM MEASURES OR CURE THE PROBLEM?** The above items are calls for donations that can make a real difference in people's lives, get a person who is not a criminal out of prison or allow a young person who is not a criminal to remain in the U.S. However, those people should not be in prison and/or under threat of deportation! A more lasting solution would be for Congress to pass the "Dream and Promise Act." PATHWAYS THROUGH THE WORSENING CRISES IN THE U.S.-MEXICO RELATIONSHIP

After months of tension between the U.S and Mexico over Trump's threats to militarily intervene in the name of U.S national security, the bilateral relationship now faces an impasse furthered by President Sheinbaum's refusal to arrest the ten Sinaloa officials charged in the United States over drug trafficking and corruption. This comes after pre-existing crises on Mexican soil and challenging trade negotiations between the U.S., Mexico, and Canada—raising the prospect of additional U.S. interventions into Mexico. Panelists on both sides of the border will delve into these crises, with an eye on each country's harm-causing approach to migration, the flow of weapons across national boundaries, and more. They will also highlight the underlying desire for cooperative approaches and the progress already made to build binational consensus on pathways ahead.

FOSNA (Friends of Sabeel North America) in partnership with local chapters, is delighted to announce that Palestinian-American activist and lawyer Huwaida Arraf will be headlining their annual speaking tour. Join the Rachel Corrie Foundation and FOSNA and the Summer of Palestinian Visibility to welcome Huwaida Arraf.

Huwaida Arraf is a Palestinian-American civil and human rights attorney and social justice activist with two decades of experience in legal, political, and grassroots initiatives for Palestinian rights. She co-founded the Nobel Peace Prize-nominated International Solidarity Movement (ISM) and led the Free Gaza Movement which, beginning in 2008, organized sea voyages to Gaza to challenge Israel's illegal blockade on the territory's two million residents.

Huwaida is a long-time friend of the Olympia-based Rachel Corrie Foundation, and the Rachel Corrie Foundation has long supported FOSNA's work. Rachel Corrie and Ayşenur Ezgi Eygi both served as nonviolent activists with the ISM - in Gaza and the West Bank respectively - when they were killed by Israeli forces.
