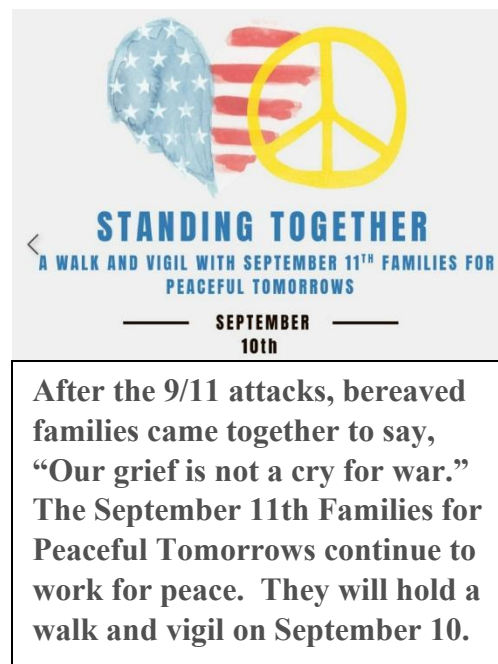

STOP & PREVENT U.S. WARS EVERYWHERE

- JUSTIFYING WARS. German Nazi leader Hermann Goring said, "Naturally, the common people don't want war ... All you have to do is to tell them they are being attacked, and denounce the pacifists for lack of patriotism and exposing the country to danger. It works the same in every country." Just as we are supposedly

being attacked by “narco-terrorists” in small boats; anti-ICE “terrorists” who are being sentenced to 50 year imprisonment; the nation of Cuba (see <https://www.state.gov/wp-content/uploads/2026/07/Cuba-Report.pdf>) which has “infiltrated the highest reaches of the U.S. government”; the nation of Iran which Trump says “would absolutely use the nuclear weapon without question.” (See

- APPRECIATING THE PEACE EFFORTS OF FORMER U.S. MILITARY. We are always pleased when we can work with antiwar veterans such as Veterans for Peace. - APPRECIATING THE PEACE EFFORTS OF FORMER ISRAELI AND PALESTINIAN COMBATANTS. Combatants for Peace <https://www.cfpeace.org/> “Founded in 2006 by former combatants on both sides, we have been committed to nonviolence since our inception.” Their commitment to peace and to working with one another has been even more strained by the increased violence since October 7, 2023. We will be privileged to have some events with visiting members of CFP in the Seattle and Olympia area, later in September, see [below](#).
- SUPPORTING THE PEOPLE WHO REFUSE TO COMMIT WAR CRIMES. Just as U.S. soldiers in the U.S. war on Vietnam played a major role in U.S. withdrawal from that conflict, current day armed forces are seeing the truth of what the U.S. is doing IN Iran and elsewhere. - *SUPPORTING THE PROSPECTIVE U.S. DRAFTEES WHO OPPOSE ALL WARS.* The U.S. does recognize the rights of conscientious objectors to refuse to serve, but it's not always easy to obtain CO status. See the Sept 12 event info [below](#) for event info as well as resources. This event is geared toward young people and will provide information helpful to obtain CO status.
- *SUPPORTING THE ISRAELI REFUSERS.* Some are opposed to participating in any wars, and some are opposed to serving as overlords in occupied territories. All Israeli Jews are expected to serve some time in the military and those who refuse are often imprisoned. "Since 2003, Resistance Solidarity Network has supported nonviolent struggle by Israeli citizens who resist war, occupation and Apartheid." See <https://www.refuser.org/> and consider a donation.

OPPOSING ICE AND BORDER PATROL VIOLENCE AND DENIAL OF RIGHTS: **First they came for the immigrants.** New York Times headline August 27, 2026, "ICE Arrests Soar as People With No Criminal Record Are Increasingly Targeted"

- *ABOLISH ICE.* We have heard of so many abuses by ICE: murders in our streets; brutality during arrests; kidnapping of peaceful community members; deportations in violation of court orders; dangerous and disgusting conditions in ICE prisons; imprisonment of children; deadly medical neglect; creating an atmosphere of fear; disrupting means of sustenance; deportations leading to deaths; and on and on. ICE cannot be reformed. Sign a petition to abolish ICE at <https://www.thepetitionsite.com/186/412/140/>.
- *IMPEACH TRUMP, SUPPORT H.RES. 1486* introduced by Rep Al Green as Trump "is **abusing the powers of the Presidency by operating ... [ICE]... as his vicious, quota-driven, unaccountable paramilitary police forces**, transgressing with anonymity and

secrecy, assaulting people, committing and covering up unjustified killings of civilians (including Renée Good, Alex Pretti, Lorenzo Salgado Araujo, and Johan Sebastián Durán Guerrero) with impunity (acting as judge, jury, prosecutor, and executioner), terrorizing communities, and brazenly and **wantonly devolving the United States democratic republic into an authoritarian regime**, where unjustified killings and coverups by ICE and CBP are normalized.” See full text at

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PAX SILICA: THE PHILIPPINES' ROLE IN PROPPING UP U.S. MILITARISM AND WAR

Tues Sept 1, 5:30 am Pacific time (not a typo, really am!), Zoom

Join us in a World BEYOND War Asia webinar on Pax Silica. Following our recently released feature article on Pax Silica, we invite you to a more in-depth discussion on this topic and how it will affect the people of the Philippines. Pax Silica is a U.S.-led coalition launched in December 2025 as the U.S. Department of State's flagship effort on artificial intelligence (AI) and supply chain security. The Philippines, as a new member this year, agreed to lease around 4,000 acres of land for 99 years to host high-tech industries and supporting businesses, functioning as a supply chain hub for artificial intelligence (AI) technology.

This partnership will not only exploit the country's resources but will also further reinforce the Philippines' role in serving the U.S.'s war games. Coalition members include Israel and other governments known for supporting military exercises and the weapons industry.

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INTRO TO UNARMED CIVILIAN PROTECTION

Tues Sept 1, 2-5 pm Pacific time, Zoom

Unarmed Civilian Protection and Accompaniment is a methodology for teams that offer direct protection of civilians and others, reduction of hostility, re-humanization of parties, as well as increasing local peace infrastructures. This workshop will be largely experiential and learning-by-doing. The skills learned can be modified and applied in many facets of life, including political demonstrations, local events, accompaniment of those in danger, neighborhood conflicts, and international conflicts. Facilitator Sal Corbin worked for 15 years in academia as a Psychology Professor before transitioning to nonprofit work with reentry, homelessness, and substance use recovery.

Objectives:

- 1) Sharing experiences of unarmed protection and accompaniment
- 2) An increased awareness of the orientation, strategies, methods, and impact of unarmed civilian protection
- 3) Acquiring skills by role-playing how peace teams use these strategies and tactics in local community conflicts
