STOP & PREVENT U.S. WARS EVERYWHERE

- WEST BANK. Sign a petition Hold the Israeli Gov Accountable for West Bank Violence at <https://act.winwithoutwar.org/act/west-bank-violence>. This petition refers to S.Res.852 calling for a report to Congress on “Israel’s human rights practices” and could be used to **stop aid to Israel**. See the sponsors of this legislation at <https://www.congress.gov/bill/119th-congress/senate-resolution/852/cosponsors>. Washington Senator Murray is a cosponsor. You could thank her and urge Senator Cantwell to do the same. See their [contact info below](#).
- NO MORE WEAPONS TO ISRAEL! Go to letter writing sites at <https://actionnetwork.org/letters/block-bombs-to-idf2/> and <https://rootsaction.org/no-more-weapons-to-israel>. There is a short letter you can modify or completely re-write to contact your 3 Congresspeople.
- SUPPORT THE ISRAELI RESISTANCE. - GAZA. FILM “NAZA” COMING SOON TO U.S. THEATERS. The film’s name is an Israeli military acronym meaning collateral damage, and it focuses on AI directed civilian killings in Gaza. Directors Yuval Abraham and Rachel Szor also co-directed the film No Oter Land about Israeli settlers taking over Palestinian villages

in West Bank, forcing displacement of peaceful residents. Watch for announcements about NAZA screenings.

- FIRED FOR SAYING “FREE PALESTINE”? [I’ll tell the truth, this WWFOR volunteer never heard of Ed Sheeran before Macklemore got fired.] Read more and sign a petition “Ed Sheeran: cancel your genocide-friendly tour” at <https://action.eko.org/a/ed-sheeran-cancel-your-genocide-friendly-tour>
- YEMEN: SENDING BOMBS TO A WAR. Like sending gasoline to a house fire. The President announced a 5 Billion Dollar sale of weapons to Saudi Arabia which has in the past bombed the Houthi controlled areas of Yemen. 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OPPOSING ICE AND BORDER PATROL VIOLENCE AND DENIAL OF RIGHTS: **First they came for the immigrants.**

- *DIFFERENT TAX RULES FOR IMMIGRANTS versus citizens. Why should lawful immigrants be denied the same benefits as citizens? - *COURT VICTORY FOR MAIL-IN VOTING – FOR NOW. The Supreme Court ruled against the Trump plan to restrict who would get a ballot – for now. At least for the upcoming midterms, ballots can be mailed to registered voters by states or counties without the Trump administration deciding who gets one.
